

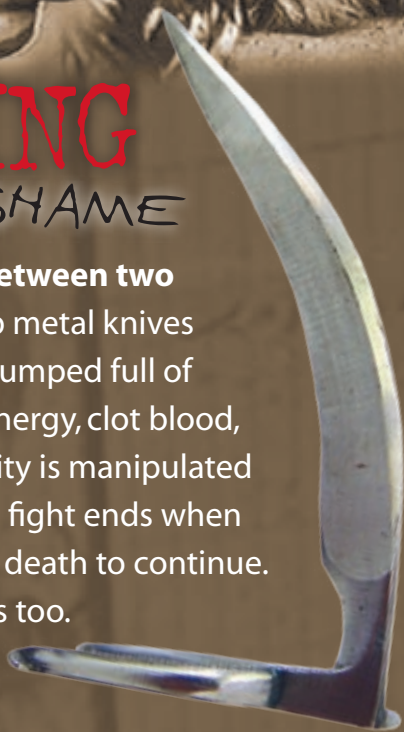

# COCKFIGHTING

## NEW MEXICO'S SHAME

**What is a cockfight? It's a knife fight between two chickens.** Roosters are armed with sharp metal knives measuring up to 3 1/2 inches long, and pumped full of drugs to heighten aggression, increase energy, clot blood, and fight fatigue. Their natural territoriality is manipulated into a showcase for illegal gambling. The fight ends when one rooster is either dead or too close to death to continue. It's a losing battle for most of the winners too.



### SOME COCKFIGHTING FACTS:

- ↓ Cockfighting is **illegal in all states** except for Louisiana and parts of New Mexico.
- ↓ Cockfighting was banned in most states in the 1800's.
- ↓ A 2001 poll showed that **81% of New Mexican voters support a ban on cockfighting.** Rural and Hispanic voters overwhelmingly agree on a statewide cockfighting ban.
- ↓ Thirteen counties & 29 municipalities in New Mexico have banned cockfighting.
- ↓ Law enforcement, the faith community, veterinarians, domestic violence prevention advocates and chambers of commerce support a cockfighting ban.

***So why haven't our lawmakers banned cockfighting?***
